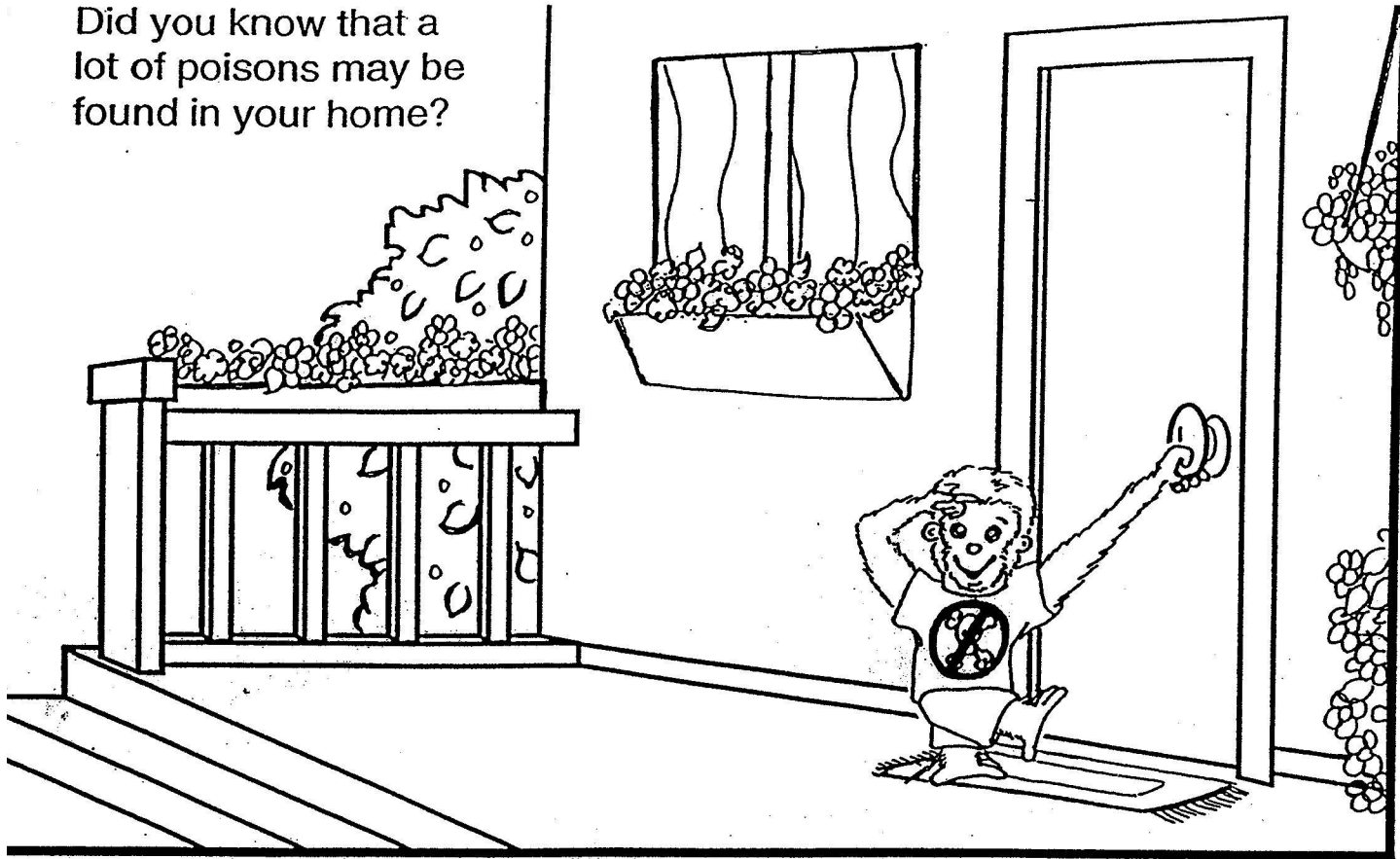

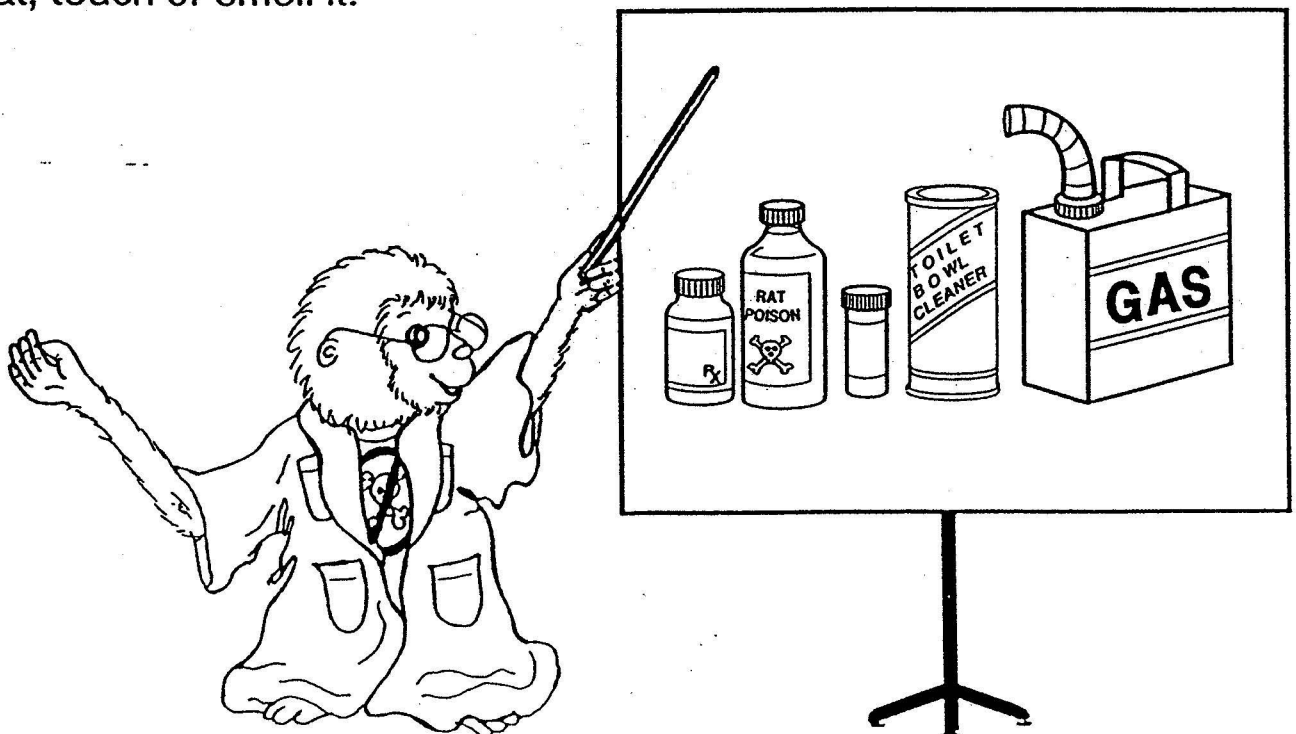

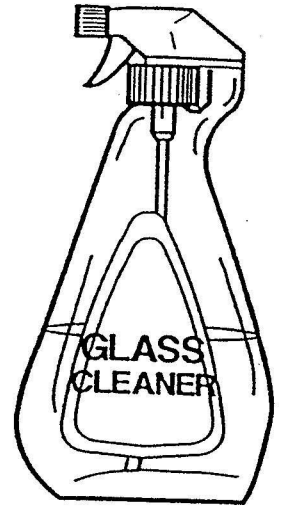
Did you know that a lot of poisons may be found in your home?



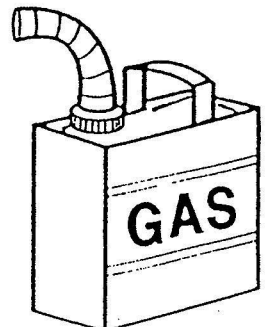
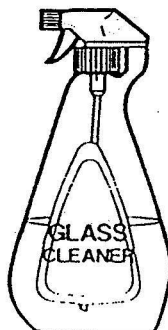
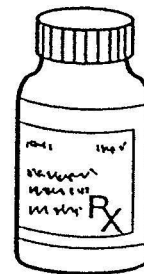
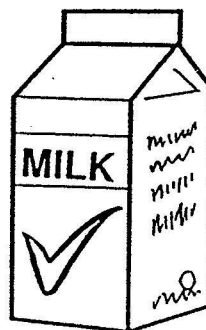
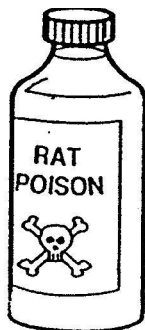
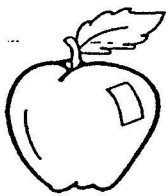
A poison can be anything that will make you sick if you drink, eat, touch or smell it!



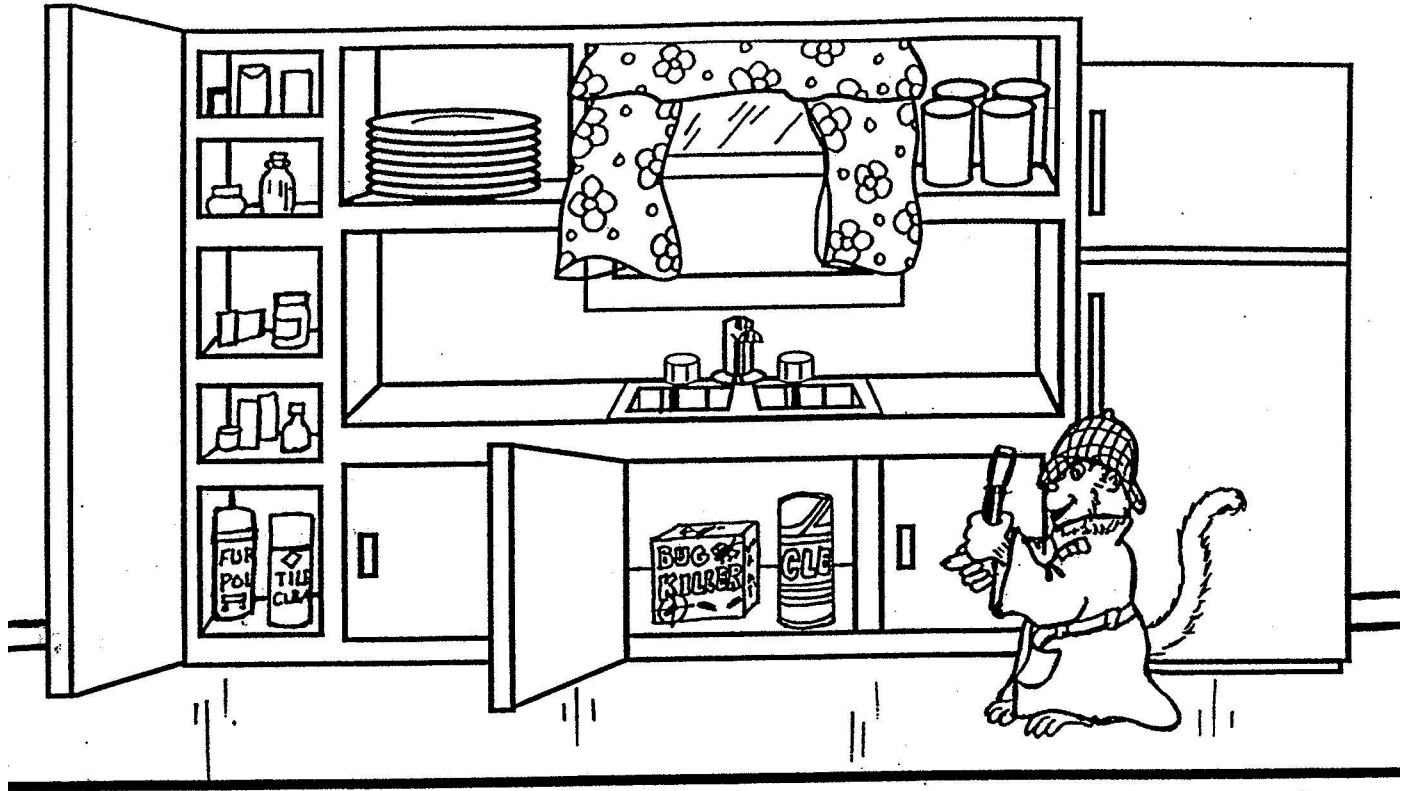
Sometimes sneaky poisons have pretty odors or look yummy.  
They are still bad, and can make you sick!



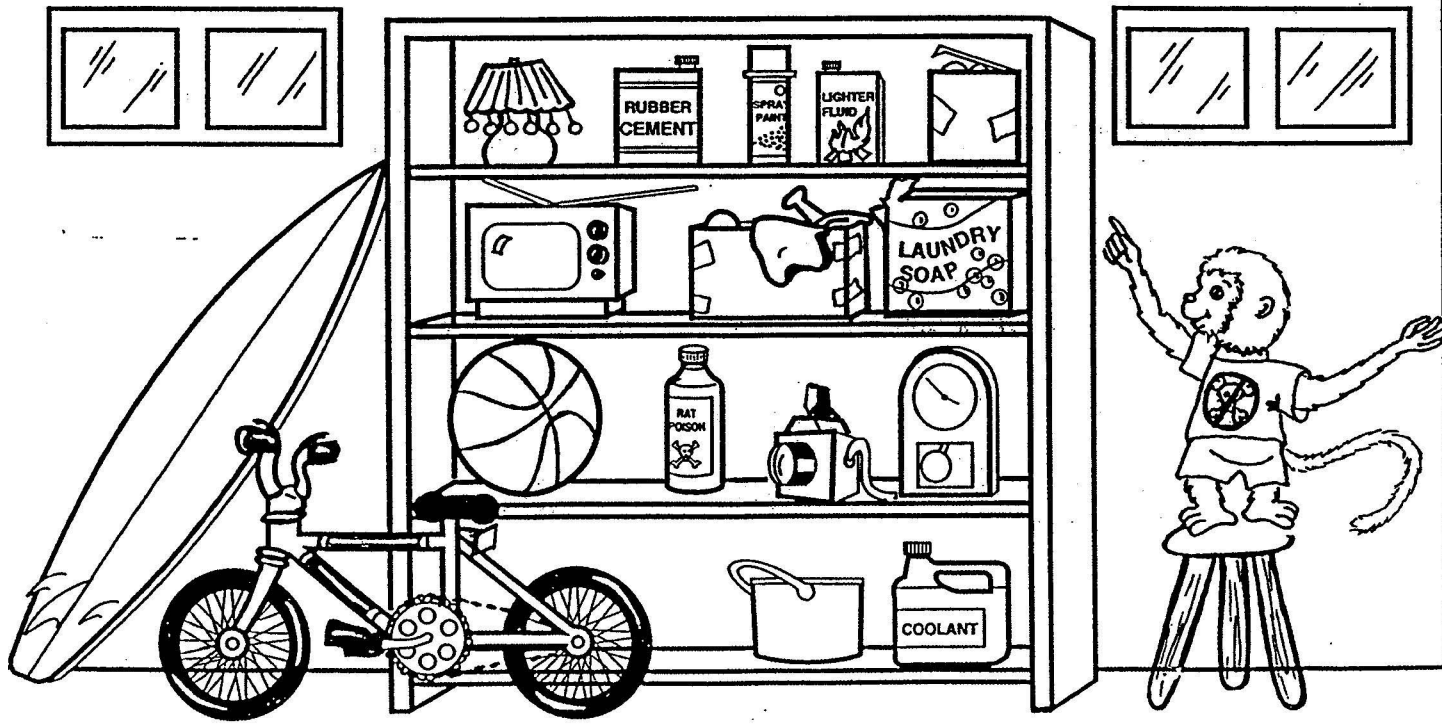
Circle the items below that are poisonous and should not be tasted.

**"I found poisons under the kitchen sink and in the kitchen cabinets."**

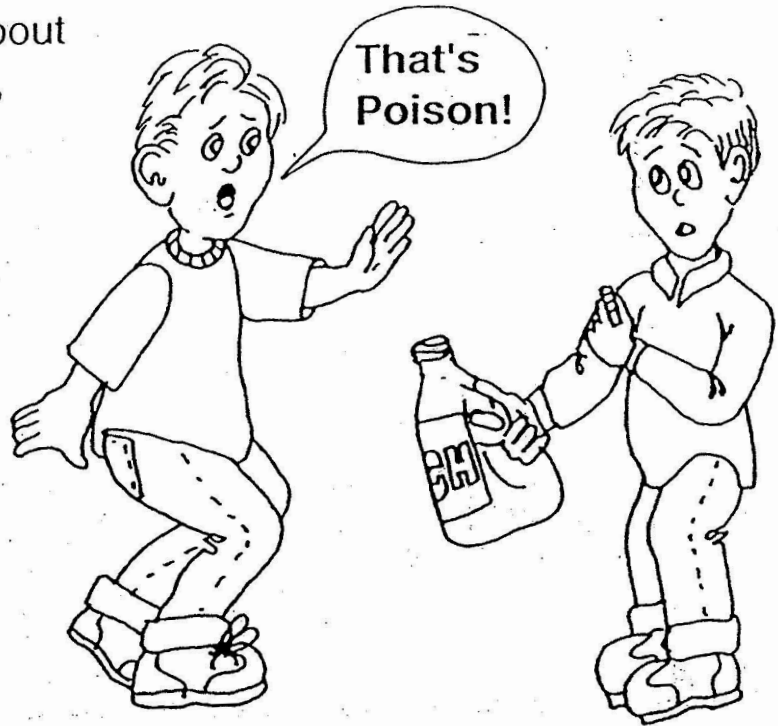
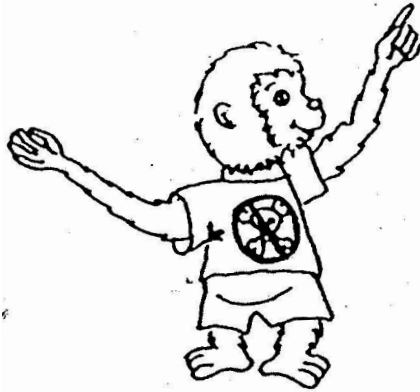


**"Be careful! Poisons can be in the basement, too!"**
