

NICOTINE AND VAPING PRODUCTS

E-cigarettes are electronic devices that heat a liquid and produce an aerosol or mix of small particles in the air.

Sometimes called vapes, e-cigs, mods, or ENDS. Vaping products come in many shapes and sizes, looking like cigars, pipes, pens, or flash drives. Marijuana oils, waxes and flower are commonly used with a variety of vaping devices.

Vaping aerosol is not a harmless water vapor; it can contain harmful substances such as:

- Nicotine.
- Flavorings such as diacetyl, and additives like vitamin E acetate have been link to serious lung injury.
- Metals such as nickel, tin or lead.
- Ultra-fine particles that can be inhaled deep into the lungs.

NICOTINE AND VAPING PRODUCTS

SYMPTOMS OF NICOTINE POISONING:

- Abdominal cramps
- Burning sensation in the mouth
- Drowsiness
- Fainting
- Heart Palpitations
- Headache
- Nausea
- Drooling
- Vomiting
- Weakness



Do not make a person throw up unless told to do so by the Poison Center or another health care professional. In some cases an exposure can lead to severe symptoms such as seizures or decreased heart rate.

The ingestion of 1 cigarette or 3 cigarette butts has been associated with signs of toxicity in children. Adults and children have also been poisoned by swallowing or absorbing vape juice from skin contact. According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, as little as one teaspoon of liquid nicotine can be fatal to a 26-pound child. Even liquid nicotine spilled on the skin can be poisonous within minutes.
